The Berterton Council Workshop was called to order by Mayor Sutton at 7:00 p.m

**IN ATTENDANCE:** Mayor Sutton, Councilman Fracassi, Councilman Gilchrest, Councilman Marcy, Councilman Pyfer, Town Attorney Yeager, Town Manager Elizabeth Greenwell, Town Clerk/Treasurer Dlugoborski and Beth Hussein, Circuit Rider.

**RESIDENTS:** Candi Sorge, Mary Ann Wasko-Smith, Dick Story, Ginny Story, Clyde Warden, Cheryl Fracassi, Bill Manners, and Brice Sutton.

Town Manager Greenwell gave a power point presentation on the results of the survey.

Circuit Rider, Beth Hussein gave a report on the Wheeler Avenue and Idlewhile Pump Station projects.

Mayor Sutton opened the bids for the Construction Management Bids. John Silcox \$23,785. Davis, Bowen & Fridel \$25,000. The budget for this project is \$22,500. The bids will be reviewed by Jim Wright, County Engineer and will vote on at another meeting.

Bayside Blvd. Closure – Bayside Blvd. West also have a severe erosion problem as well as Bayside Blvd. East. Letters will be sent out to the residents in the area that are effected by the temporary closure as well as an email blast. Bayside Alley will be one way from Park to Glen and Bayview Drive to Glen. Possibly putting barriers at the areas where the erosion is the worst. Signs will be ordered for temporary road closure, one way signs, do not enter, emergency vehicles only, detour, etc. *Councilman Marcy made a motion for the temporary closure of both East and West Bayside Blvd, Councilman Gilchrest seconded; all in favor.* The temporary road closure will be effective Friday, May 10, 2019.

Light on Second Avenue – Councilman Marcy commented that it is very dark in the area with the light out. We have to err on safety. Councilman Gilchrest and Councilman Pyfer also commented about being too dark in that area. Councilman Fracassi stated that there are several “dark” spots all around town. Second Avenue is a one-way street and people tend to drive the wrong way. Council decided to have the light turned back on. Town Manager Greenwell will contact Delmarva Power.

**OPEN FORUM:**

Question was asked if the new post office would be open soon? The Postmaster had sent notice that they were hoping to be open by the end of April.
