**PUBLIC HEARING**

Mayor Sutton opened the Public Hearing at 7:05 p.m. The public hearing is to consider Resolution 2020-01, to increase the sewer rate from \$170.00 per quarter to \$204.50 per quarter. Water rate would remain the same. Mayor Sutton read into record the public notice that was in the Kent County News on June 18, 2020, then Resolution 2020-01. Mayor Sutton opened the floor for discussion. There was brief discussion. Councilman Fracassi motioned to closed the public hearing; Councilman Gilchrest seconded; all in favor; motion carried.

Councilman Marcy motioned to adopt Resolution 2020-01 Sewer Rate Increase from \$170.00 per quarter to \$204.50 per quarter for flat rate usage; Councilman Fracassi seconded; all in favor; motion carried.

The rate increase is effective July 1, 2020 and will be on the September 2020 billing.

Joe Sanders asked which way is the one-way on Wheeler Ave. Mayor Sutton explained it is one-way from Main Street to Ericsson Avenue.

Arbor Play Area at the Sixth Avenue Park will be a few more weeks before it is finished.
